Dear John Gill:

As per the suggestion of Charles W. Stone, I am requesting the United States
Senate "Committee on the Judiciary" to investigate my extradition from Brazil
to the United States, as to:

1. Lambros' illegal arrest in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil on unextraditable crimes;
2. Lambros' illegal transfer to Brasilia, Brazil from Rio de Janeiro, Brazil
without arraignment or bail hearing;
3. Lambros being tortured in Brasilia, Brazil;
4. Lambros being denied due process of the Brazilian Criminal Code, Brazilian
Constitution, and the Extradition Treaty Between the United States of America and
Brazil;
5. Lambros being denied due process of the Brazilian Criminal Code, Brazilian
Constitution, and the Extradition Treaty Between the U.S. and Brazil during PLEA
AGREEMENT negotiation in the United States on or about November 16, 1992, that
has carried forward to this point in time.

Attached for your review and filing is my August 09, 2001, AFFIDAVIT OF JOHN GREGORY
LAMBROS, which is seventeen (17) pages in length, not including attached exhibits.

Please forward any and all procedure and/or rules of the U.S. Senate "Committee on
the Judiciary" so I may communicate more effectively in your investigation.

I am authorizing you to release "COPY" of all correspondence, if requested, to Charles
W. Stone. Also, feel free to discuss your investigation with Charles W. Stone, as to
this investigation, as Mr. Stone has spend a considerable amount of time researching
facts and legal opinions as to my claims in this action.
