

2. Lambros' illegal transfer to Brasilia, Brazil from Rio de Janeiro, Brazil without arraignment or bail hearings;
3. Lambros being tortured in Brasilia, Brazil;
4. Lambros being denied due process of the Brazilian Criminal Code, Brazilian Constitution, and the Extradition Treaty Between the United States of America and Brazil;
5. Lambros being denied due process of the Brazilian Criminal Code, Brazilian Constitution, and the Extradition Treaty Between the U.S. and Brazil during PLEA AGREEMENT negotiation in the United States on or about November 16, 1992, that has carried forward to this point in time.

Attached for your review and filing is my August 09, 2001, AFFIDAVIT OF JOHN GREGORY LAMBROS, which is seventeen (17) pages in length, not including attached exhibits.



PRISON AND LEGAL NEWS

A TEXAS inmate with many mental diagnoses tells of his conditions in prison. "In this mental hospital area, patients are routinely denied a chance to eat if they disobey any minor rules, AT THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICER'S DISCRETION. Patients receive disciplinary cases exactly like the "normal" population. I have witnessed patients being physically abused by the staff, including one incident where a patient was beaten half to death by three officers for "not eating fast enough" and of course, the patient was charged with the offense, the officers claiming the patient swung on them. The inmate witnesses to the contrary, (that the patient did not resist or swing on any officers) were dismissed as lies. One officer boasted of "having already broken one inmate's neck" killing him. The Warden covered up all reports by saying the offender died of a heart attack. abuse, but no mental health treatment is given there.

A SOUTH CAROLINA inmate reports that the staff responded quickly with the best of medical care at Lieber CI and Richland Memorial Cardiac Center in SC. IT CAN BE DONE RIGHT!

A PENNSYLVANIA prisoner asks, "If you have a problem with staff destroying your mail, and another staff member is willing to verify this, who should a prisoner contact about mail being tampered with and destroyed?" Any good answers?

An OHIO prisoner asks: How can a prisoner obtain legal help for "family matters". Most prisoners request help with their cases, or the courts, or for relief from prison abuses. This gentleman needs help with family matters and is indigent (the prison word for poor, broke, helpless). He didn't know where to find an attorney, even if he had money. Certainly prisoners who take responsibility and want their family provided for need these services. Send ideas on how to get "pro-bono" help to us!

Believe you are a victim of an ex-post facto clause? (If defense attorney did not present the correct defense, this is an ex-post facto violation.) In law library look up *Carmell v. Texas*, 120 set 1620.

Category 1. Charged with a crime when the act was legal.

Category 2. Charged with greater crime than the one committed.

Category 3. Punishment given greater than in effect that the time the crime was committed.

Category 4. 'less and different' testimony used to get a conviction than the law required. (Psychiatric testimony used to convict rather than the facts of the case.)

A FIDELITY BOND is an insurance policy that protects an employer against loss from employee theft of money or property. An ex-prisoner is often "not bondable" and is denied employment due to this. A Federal Funding Program can help. It issues a special fidelity bond to insure ex-prisoners for free for 6 months. If the person bonded proves to be an honest employee during that time, the underwriter will sell the bond in future years at a regular commercial rate. To be eligible, you need to be qualified to perform the duties of the job opening and be offered at least 30 hours work per week.
