As a torture victim from Brazil that was also denied due process of law in my extradition to the United States in 1992, I am requesting your company, who is known to:

a. buy 150 - 40-foot containers of Brazilian meat per month from Bertin Ltd., a meatpacker in the the heart of Brazil's cattle country;

to forward a letter to Bertin Ltd. and Brazilian Government Officials as to judiciary investigation and current actions in exposing the torture I received in Brasilia, Brazil in 1991 and 1992.

I have also contacted Hormel Foods for their assistance to no avail.


